

Statistics assistant needed – AISSR MATCH study

The AISSR is currently engaged in the MATCH study (Multi-country African study on HIV Counselling and Testing, see <http://www.cghi.nl/14> for a project description). In collaboration with WHO and teams from Burkina Faso, Kenya, Malawi and Uganda, we have developed large qualitative and quantitative datasets on the ethics and everyday practices of HIV counselling and testing in the four participating countries.

We are now in need of assistance in the preliminary analysis and presentation of the quantitative data, and are therefore seeking someone who is:

- Well acquainted with STATA and Excel;
- Able to conduct simple statistical tests (basic frequencies, cross tabulations, chi square etc);
- Produce tables and other graphics for data presentation.

We anticipate that the work will take about 12 hours a week for the first two weeks, and around 8 hours a week thereafter, for approximately two months. A more detailed timetable, as well as the level of remuneration, will be agreed during discussion with the successful candidate.
